Secretary's Report

Director's Report

- The popular museum pass service has returned with the reopening of the library. We have new software that allows some passes to be printed out right from home or downloaded to your phone. Not all museums are open yet so the number passes is limited.
- The Friends are having a pop-up book sale outside under the portico on Saturday, June 26th. They have a lot of inventory so we will hopefully have a busy day!
- Bob with help from Keith from Facilities got the A/C up and running. The custodians continue to clean and paint. The Garden Club has planted annuals near the main entrance.
- Best Bees has setup the hive after a delay in getting the bees up from Georgia.
 The Andy Zuckerman Fund is funding the annual cost for the maintenance of the bees.

Unfinished Business

- Annual Town Meeting: The Library's HVAC project was approved by a majority vote after some discussion. The library budget passed unanimously.

The Director mentioned most staff members and patrons were wearing masks anyway. Plexiglas had been installed at the circulation and reference desks.
- Children's Room Project supply chain delays have left this project in limbo for the moment. Our vendor, Tucker Interiors is still waiting for the shelving to be finished.

- Fines discussion: The Board discussed the continuation of the no fines policy now that the library has reopened.
