## Entering the Library

The circulation desk will be the first thing I see at the library. I can return my library materials in the book drop. I can use the book drop inside or outside the library.


## Masks

Some people at the library may be wearing a mask.

But that's alright. Even though they're covering their faces, I can still talk to them. They may even be smiling under their masks!


## Library Staff

The Library Staff are the people who work at the library.

The librarians are always ready to help me if I need to find something or answer my questions.

The custodians are the people who clean the library.


## Things to Remember

There are different areas to explore in the children's room. I must stay with my parent, grandparent, or grown-up at all times.

I cannot eat in the library.
I can have a drink if my cup or bottle has a cover.

I may even make a friend.


## Murphy the Turtle

When I walk into the library, I can say hello to Murphy the Turtle. He lives in the tank next to the librarian's desk.


## The Coloring Station

The coloring station is where I can draw on the coloring pages provided by the librarians at the front desk. I can color with either crayons or colored pencils.


## The Computers

There are three computers in the Children's Room. I can use the computers to look up books, read books or play games. I need a library card to use the computers. If I forget my library card, I can ask a librarian for help.


## The Playspace

The Playspace is where I can play with all sorts of interesting toys.

The Playspace changes toys about every month. There are always something new to play with!


## The Puppets and Puzzles Area

Near the picture books, I will find puppets and puzzles. I can play with the puppets and puzzles at the library or I can check them out and take them home.


## Listening Station

Near the puppets and puzzles, there is the Listening Station. I can pick one of the read-along picture books from the shelf and listen to the story on the iPad with one of the four headphones.


## Finding Books!

I can ask the librarian at the children's desk to help me find picture books, books about facts, chapter books, graphic novels, and books in different languages!


## More than books!

At the library I can borrow more than books. The library also has

- Puppets
- Puzzles
- Launchpads (individual tablets)
- Videogames
- Movies
- Music


## Library Events

I can also attend fun events at the library like storytime, music programs, crafts and more.

Most events are drop-in, but sometimes I have to sign up ahead of time. I can learn more on the library calendar.


## Checking Out

Once I have everything I need from the Children's Room, I need to check out my items. I can go to the Circulation desk and a librarian will help me, or I can do it myself at our self-checkout.


## Library Card

I can ask the librarian at the Circulation desk to give me my own library card.


## Time to Leave

When I am done with my visit to the library, I will exit the building with my parent/grandparent/grown-up with me at all times.
